"Auras" is Tivadar Boté's second exhibition with the Herringer Kiss Gallery, following the success of his 2003 exhibition, "Meditative Works". Tivadar Boté's large-scale paintings are like excavations. Canvases are layered with washes of translucent paint and finished with bold brushstrokes and deep pools of colour. The work is both lyrical and dramatic and expresses the artist's joy of painting.

Tivadar Boté was born in Hungary but has lived in Calgary for many years. He received a degree in Fine Art from the Alberta College of Art and Design, a degree in Art Education from the University of Calgary and studied traditional Japanese woodblock at the Yoshida Hanga Academy in Tokyo, Japan. Tivadar is a faculty member at the Alberta College where he has been teaching since 1995.
